Medication in school

May I politely request that that in the very rare cases when doctors insist prescribed medicines are taken in school time and parents cannot come into school themselves to give their child their medicine then parents may request medication in school time. In such rare instances please place the child's full name on the medicine and complete a medicine slip. We cannot give non prescribed over the counter medicines to children. It is also the parent's responsibility to collect the medicine after 7 days (or after

the course of treatment) if this is not done the medicine will be disposed of safely on your behalf.
