1.6 Behaviours that will result in Exclusion (fixed term, external)

- **Wilful violence/attacks towards teachers**
 - **Abscond from school premises (e.g. escape over fence/gate)**
 - **Extended abscond from classroom (e.g. longer than 15 minutes with no attempt to return)/repeated attempted abscond from premises**
- Repeated behaviours from 1.5 above**

The reason that I am asking for this change is to ensure that my decision to exclude will be transparent and fair to all children and parents. Exclusion has never been taken lightly at Chad Vale and I always exclude with a very heavy heart. However I do feel that the above behaviours can no longer be treated subjectively but rather objectively with a clear cut response agreed by the Chad Vale Family.

Please may I remind parents that their child must comply with the School Uniform Policy at all times. I am very grateful that the vast majority of parents who follow the policy to the letter however, there is one area that is less than perfect: shoes. The school requires that all children to attend school in plain black/dark or brown shoes (no logos or flashing lights please). Of course boots can be worn if the weather is poor. If you wish your child to wear trainers when playing outside then of course your child can change into them but they must change back into shoes at the start of learning sessions. If any parent is struggling to meet the uniform requirements then please do not hesitate to have a quiet word with me and I will do all I can to support you further.
